The cake stall is always popular on carnival day. Why not try making simple sponge cakes?

Makes 18 squares. Ice the cakes with sugar icing and decorate with small sweets.

For the squares: 275g self-raising flour, 225g soft margarine, 4 tablespoons of milk, 1 level teaspoon of baking powder, 225g caster sugar, 2-3 drops of vanilla essence, 4 eggs. Plus a 33x25cm roasting tin.

For the sugar icing: 225g icing sugar and about 2 tablespoons of water. Plus small sweets for decorating.

1. Grease the tin. Draw around it on baking parchment or greaseproof paper. Cut out the shape and put it in the tin.
2. Turn the oven on to 180C, 350F or gas mark 4. Put a sieve over a large mixing bowl and sift the flour through it.
3. Add the margarine, milk, baking powder, sugar and vanilla. Break the eggs into a small bowl, then add them too. Beat everything well.
4. Scrape the mixture into the tin and smooth the top. Bake it for 40-45 minutes, until the cake springs up when you press the middle.
5. Make the icing when the cake has cooled completely. Sift the icing sugar into a bowl, add a little water and stir. Add some more water and stir it again. Continue to do this until the icing coats the back of the spoon and dribbles off it.
6. Lift the cake out of the tin, then spread the icing over it. Cut the cake into squares and decorate each piece before the icing sets.
